## Coaching Accreditation Scheme

### UPDATING GUIDELINES

Updating of Coaches Accreditation is required every 4 years. To update your Coach Accreditation you have 3 options:

**1. Reaccredit at the current level by completing the required 24 hours of updating activities;**

There are 24 hours of updating activities required to update and retain Level 1 Accreditation without attending another course. Fee to update is \$60. The Updating Application form must be submitted.

**Please note: Accreditation must be updated by the expiry date, after this time you will no longer be recognized as having Coaching Accreditation and you will have to attend a Coaching Level 1 Course to regain your accreditation and continue to coach.)**

6 hours	<b>Practical Coaching</b> Self Monitored. Signed off in the Coach log book or on documentation produced by the applicant	<b>Practical coaching</b> can be undertaken with any level of athlete, team or official and may occur on a regular basis, weekly or fortnightly. It may occur in specific situations such as at camps or clinics.
6 hours	<b>Practical Coaching</b> Monitored by the State Coaching Coordinator, State Coach or Head Instructor. Signed off in the Coach log book or on documentation produced by the applicant	
COACH EDUCATION		
12 hours	<b>Coach Education</b> Monitored by the State Coaching Coordinator, State Coach or Head Instructor, or other person responsible for validating the activity took place. Signed off in the Coach log book and/or on documentation produced by the applicant	<b>Coach Education</b> may INCLUDE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lecture or presentation at a coaching course</li> <li>• Becoming a mentor for another coach</li> <li>• Supervising practical coaching hours for another coach</li> <li>• Writing and/or publishing an article on an aspect relating to coaching</li> </ul>
24 hours	<b>Log Book and Documentation</b>	

**2. Reaccredit at the current level by enrolling in and completing another Coaching Level 1 Course**

Please find the contact details of your state Coaching Coordinator and course calendar by logging on to the Taekwondo Australia website ([www.taekwondoaustralia.org](http://www.taekwondoaustralia.org)).

Course fee is \$200 for Coaching Level 1, and the course is generally conducted over two days. Some courses are offered through an external program for the General Principles Level 1 and attendance at a one day sport specific Level 1 Program.

**3. Complete the next level of accreditation to Coaching Level 2**

The Coaching Level 2 program has a General Principles 2 component and a sport specific component. The General Principles program is one of a number of requirements to gain Level 2 Accreditation. However, General Principles Level 2 is a prerequisite to all other Level 2 requirements.
